CONCORD, NH – **Emily Knouse** (Loudon, NH) marked 12 points for the Lynx in the 9-0 victory of the Huskies on Saturday with five goals and a pair of assists. **Knouse** was one of four goal scorers on the day as **Kallesta Selby** (Newbury, NH) buried two goals and two helpers, **Madisyn Buteau** (Gorham, NH) got her third header goal of the year and **Emily Weldon** (Pembroke, NH) score her first collegiate goal.

NHTI also had five Lynx get assists as **Knouse**, **Selby**, **Morgan Rule** (Loudon, NH) and **Alexis Deming** (Jefferson, NH) had two helpers. **Gwendalynn Knipping** (Gilford, NH) added her first assist of the season. On the backend **Madison Lima** (Belmont, NH) notched a five save shutout to mark her third in four games.
