CONCORD, NH – The Lynx women's soccer team dropped their first contest on the season as the Bobcats defeated the Lynx by a 2-1 final.

Madison Lima (Belmont, NH) was the star of the show for NHTI making 12 saves including a penalty kick save and always keeping the game within reach. Paul Smith's College outshot the Lynx by a 39 to 6 margin, while also taking seven corner kicks versus zero for the home team.

After a Paul Smith goal in the 49th minute, NHTI evened the score as a set play from **Jaycee Murray** (Lancaster, NH) found **Emily Knouse** (Loudon, NH) who placed the ball into the net for the 1-1 tie. Later on, the Bobcats took a breakaway with Samantha Serving tallying the game winner.
